



What are the Junior Advisors?

If you are an outgoing teenager with an active interest in community involvement and take a special pride in the annual Evergreen State Fair, then we are looking for you!

Evergreen Fair Foundation (EFF) Junior Advisors have the opportunity to learn about our fair and the fair industry, increase agriculture education to our guests, get involved with the community, participate in community service, expand your leadership skills and be involved with an amazing group of like-minded youth working to make our fair better each year.

The EFF Junior Advisors are made up of students from 14-18 years old. Youth wishing to serve on the board will need to submit an application. After the applications are reviewed prospective members are interviewed by the EFF panel.

What do Junior Fair Board members do?

- We serve as ambassadors for the Evergreen State Fair:
 - Attend regularly scheduled meetings of the EFF.
 - Be familiar with activities of the EFF through cooperative interaction with the EFF
 - We participate in local events.
- We help out in the community:
 - We assist the EFF with their sponsored year-round activities (i.e., barrel races, holiday bazaar, etc.)
- During fair:
 - Plan at least one special activity during the Fair.
 - Make suggestions to the EFF regarding any facet of the Evergreen State Fair.
 - We attend the Opening ceremonies for the fair.
 - We continue to bring agriculture education to the public through many different displays at the fair.
 - We shadow Board members and staff in their duties during fair.
 - We help out fair staff whenever needed.

The requirements are simple – you must currently be 14-18 years old. Applicants must be willing to make the activities of the Junior Advisors your top priority up to and during the Evergreen State Fair as well as a few events during other times of the year. Applicants need not be members of 4-H or FFA.
